Drawing animals can be fun, and it's not as hard as you might think. By following step-by-step instructions in this article, you can learn how to draw many different kinds of creatures. Before you start drawing, there are some basic tools you need. Make sure you have a pen, a pencil sharpener, an eraser, a felt-tip pen and paper. Ad Animal sketches begin with larger basic shapes such as ovals, rectangles and triangles. Draw the full shape, although all it will not be seen in the final drawing. You can delete the part you don't need later. Each successive step adds more detail until you have the finished animal drawing. The steps are colored to show exactly what to draw when.
